Dr. Tommy W. Smith is a Graduate of New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and has a master degree in Divinity (1980), and a master degree in Marriage and Family Therapy (1998). He also has a Doctorate degree in Christian Counseling. Tommy served churches as a pastor and Bible teacher for 28 years in Ms and AL. After serving in Desert Storm as an Army Chaplain, he went into full time work as a professional counselor. **He is licensed by the State of Alabama as a marriage and family therapist. He is a certified Professional Christian Counselor.**
